**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF JOHN HAARLOW, JR.
IN SUPPORT OF CELINE’S MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION
AND REGARDING THE COURT’S OCTOBER 30, 2024 ORDER**

I, John Haarlow, Jr. declare as follows:

1. I am an attorney at law, duly admitted to practice before the Courts of the State of Illinois and the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois. I am one of the attorneys for Plaintiff Celine SA (“Celine”). Except as otherwise expressly stated to the contrary, I have personal knowledge of the following facts and, if called as a witness, I could and would competently testify as follows:

2. On October 15, 2024, the Court entered a Temporary Restraining Order (“TRO”) providing that Celine may provide notice of these proceedings to Defendants, including notice of the preliminary injunction hearing, service of process pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(f)(3), and any future motions, by electronically publishing a link to the Complaint, the TRO and other relevant documents on a website, and by sending an e-mail to the e-mail addresses identified in Exhibit 2 to the Declaration of Nicolas Lambert and any e-mail addresses provided for Defendants by third parties that includes a link to said website.

3. On October 22, 2024, the Court extended the TRO until November 12, 2024. (Dkt. 32.)

4. On October 31, 2024, Celine sent an email to all Defendants at the addresses identified in Exhibit 2 to the Declaration of Nicolas Lambert and e-mail addresses provided for Defendants by third parties. The email contained a link to a website containing the Complaint, the TRO and motion papers relating thereto, the Motion for Preliminary Injunction and Memorandum and Declaration in support thereof, and other relevant documents.

5. Also on October 31, 2024, Celine sent an email to Defendants attaching a copy of the Court's October 30, 2024 Order (Dkt. 36) and containing the statement required by that Order: "The Court has taken the motion for a preliminary injunction under advisement and will consider the motion unopposed if no Defendant appears and objects by November 4, 2024."

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the foregoing is true and correct.
