MINUTE entry before the Honorable April M. Perry: Hearing held 12/19/2024 on Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment [34], which is entered and continued to 1/31/2025 at 10:00 a.m. in person in Courtroom 1725. As was elaborated upon in court, the current request for \$500,000 in statutory damages from each of the 40 remaining defendants without any case-specific or defendant-specific evidence supporting it is insufficient. Plaintiff is invited to file supplemental briefing supporting damages describing all relevant factors with respect to specific Defendants, including (but not limited to): evidence related to how long each Defendant has been engaged in counterfeit sales, how many different products have been sold, how much money has been seized and how many sales have been conducted on online platforms (presumably disclosed during expedited discovery), and whether certain Defendants are believed to be the same individuals (as evidenced by shared email addresses and/or names). Supplemental briefing to be filed by 1/17/2025. Plaintiff is also directed to serve this Order and a copy of its Default Judgment motion upon all parties no later than 1/15/2025, and file proof of service on the docket. Plaintiff's request for permanent injunctive relief is granted. Unless the Plaintiff files a written objection by 12/23/2025, the Clerk is instructed to lift the seal on all of the filings that have been placed under seal. Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction [29] is denied as moot. Enter order. Mailed notice. (jcc,)
